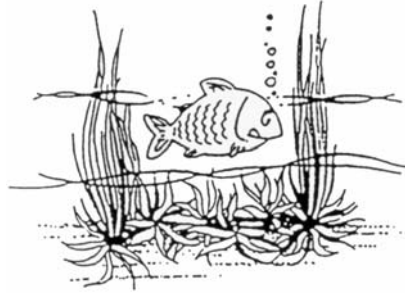


MOSQUITO PROBLEMS START AT HOME

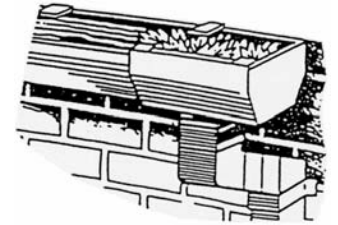
Don't give mosquitoes a chance.

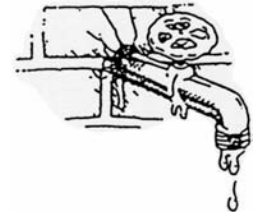
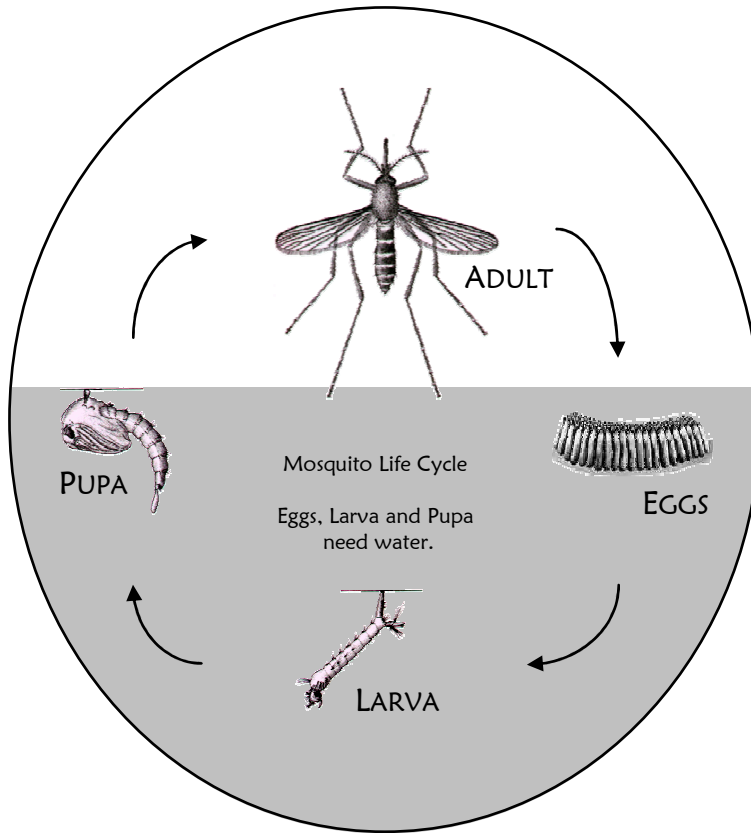

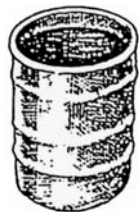
